AIDS TO NAVIGATION

The Port of Wisbech Harbour Authority request Mariners navigating within its jurisdiction to exercise the greatest care to avoid damage to floating Aids to Navigation.

Mariners should give all navigational buoys a wide berth, always having regard for the strength of the wind and tide, and are requested to report immediately any defect in any Aid to Navigation either to Port of Wisbech Harbour Authority (telephone 01945 588059), or to HM Coastguard.

The Merchant Shipping Act 1995 makes provisions for the imposition of a fine on any person who willfully or negligently runs afoul of, or makes fast to, any Buoy or Beacon, and for the recovery of the expenses for making good any resulting damage.

Vessels should maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 9 and 16.
