



Activity for years 1 and 2

The items below are commonly found in the bathroom and are not recyclable.



Toilet tissues can be flushed, other tissue such as kitchen roll, baby wipes and facial wipes should never be flushed. These go in the green bin.



Nappies, sanitary items, bandages and dressings are not recyclable and not flushable. These go in the green bin.



Batteries should never be placed in any bin. Dispose of these at designated battery banks, a local household recycling centre or return them to the shop for them to dispose of them safely. Remember, even a dead battery can cause a fire and leak harmful chemicals.



Clothing including bags, shoes, belts, towels and scrap materials should be taken to clothes banks. Even damaged textiles can be recycled at a clothes bank. Never flush textiles, and please do not put textiles in the blue recycle bin, they can be mixed with glass which is unsafe.

Some other items that cannot be recycled and need to go in the green bin include:



Remember to empty full containers, rinse/ wash them and let them dry Toothbrushes
Toothpaste tubes
Contact lens
Cotton buds
Disposables razors
Hairbrushes
Bin bags
Makeup products
Sponges
Soap pumps



Recycling that isn't clean cannot be recycled either and can ruin the rest of the recycling

Activity for years 1 and 2

The items below are commonly found in the kitchen and are not recyclable.



Plastic pouches are not recyclable, however, some specialist collectors like Terracycle will take them (As long as they are washed). Look for a local drop off near you. Otherwise, these go in the green bin.



Crisp packets are not recyclable, however, some specialist collectors like Terracycle will take them.
Look for a local drop off near you. Otherwise, these go in the green bin.



Toilet tissues can be flushed, other tissue such as kitchen roll, baby wipes and facial wipes should never be flushed. These go in the green bin.



Polystyrene, like food trays cannot be recycled. These go in the green bin.



Batteries should never be placed in any bin. Dispose of these at designated battery banks, a local household recycling centre or return them to the shop for them to dispose of them safely. Remember, even a dead battery can cause a fire and leak harmful chemicals.



Uncooked fruit and vegetable waste can be composted.
Other food will need to go in the green bin.

*The Scrunch Test – Scrunch your wrappers into a ball, if they remain in a ball they can be recycled and placed in the blue bin. If they pop open, they cannot be recycled and will need to go in the green bin.

Some other items that cannot be recycled and need to go in the green bin include:

Tea bags Cling film All wrappers - that fail the scrunch test* Black sacks Dish cloths Baking paper Coffee pods Medical blister packets Cleaning wipes Sponges






Teachers Answers





