

# Ukraine Family Scheme



The Ukraine Family Scheme allows applicants to join family members, or extend their stay, in the UK.

National Government process

## To be eligible you must:

- Be applying to join or accompany your UK-based family member who should be either a British national or who is settled in the UK
- Someone who has pre-settled status under the EUSS if they started living in the UK before 1 January
- Someone with refugee status or humanitarian protection in the UK

Your UK-based family member **must be** one of the following:

- **An immediate family member** - spouse or civil partner/unmarried partner
- **Extended family member** - parent (if you are over 18)/child who is over 18/grandparent/grandchild or your partner's grandchild/brother or sister
- **Immediate family member of an extended family member** - spouse or civil partner of an extended family member
- **Additionally**, you may also be eligible if you are a Ukrainian or the immediate family member of a Ukrainian national who is applying to the scheme and have been residing in Ukraine prior to 1 January 2022
