Alcohol will not be sold to anyone who appears to be drunk or behaving aggressively. Challenge 25 policy will be implemented.

Notices warning customers not to leave bag unattended. Signs placed stating restrictions on sale of liquor under 18. Challenge 25 Policy to be maintained. Inform the use of CCTV Cameras. Fire Extinguisher to be maintained An accident book will be maintained Serious incidents will be reported to the relevant authorities where required. Floors will be kept clean, dry, and free of obstacles to reduce the risk of slips and falls

There will be no disturbances by staff leaving the premises after closing hours. Deliveries and waste collections will take place during reasonable daytime hours to minimise disturbance

Providing training for staff to recognize false identification. A Challenge 25 age verification policy in place. Anyone who appears to be under 25 will be asked to produce valid photo ID. Staff will receive training on how to verify ID and handle refusals appropriately.
