PART B: REPRESENTATION

These representations are made by the Fisher Parkinson Trust and include land owned by Mr & Mrs Gillett, which is the subject of a separate representation submitted by John Martin & Associates. The land to the south west of March, extends to some 27.7 hectares and is identified in pink on the attached plan.

Representations were previously submitted by the Fisher Parkinson Trust in August 2012 (Core Strategy DPD; Further Consultation Draft July 2011) and April 2013 (Fenland Core Strategy Development Plan Document).

The land is situated within the area identified as the 'Broad Locations for Growth' on the 'Key Diagram for March'. It is located to the south west of March between Wimblington Road and the Isle of Ely Way.

Further comments

The proposed North-East March Allocation proved to be extremely unpopular with hundreds of local residents. They feared the loss of the only playing field in the town which is open to the public. In reality, the homes earmarked for that area will need to be allocated elsewhere. Thus, the redistribution of housing growth with the addition of 200 dwellings to the South West March allocation, are both fully supported.

The Sustainability Appraisal February 2013 welcomes the principle of additional development in the southern half of March, since it is preferable in sustainability terms than to the north. The momentum and scale of development in the south, is more likely to achieve a balanced positive outcome.

The Sustainability Appraisal reaches conclusions which express a preference for perspective growth in the southern segment first.

The Fisher Parkinson Trust are working with the other major landowner to ensure the deliverability of a comprehensive development, through the preparation of a master plan.

The proposed changes sought in the proposed Addendum are welcomed.
